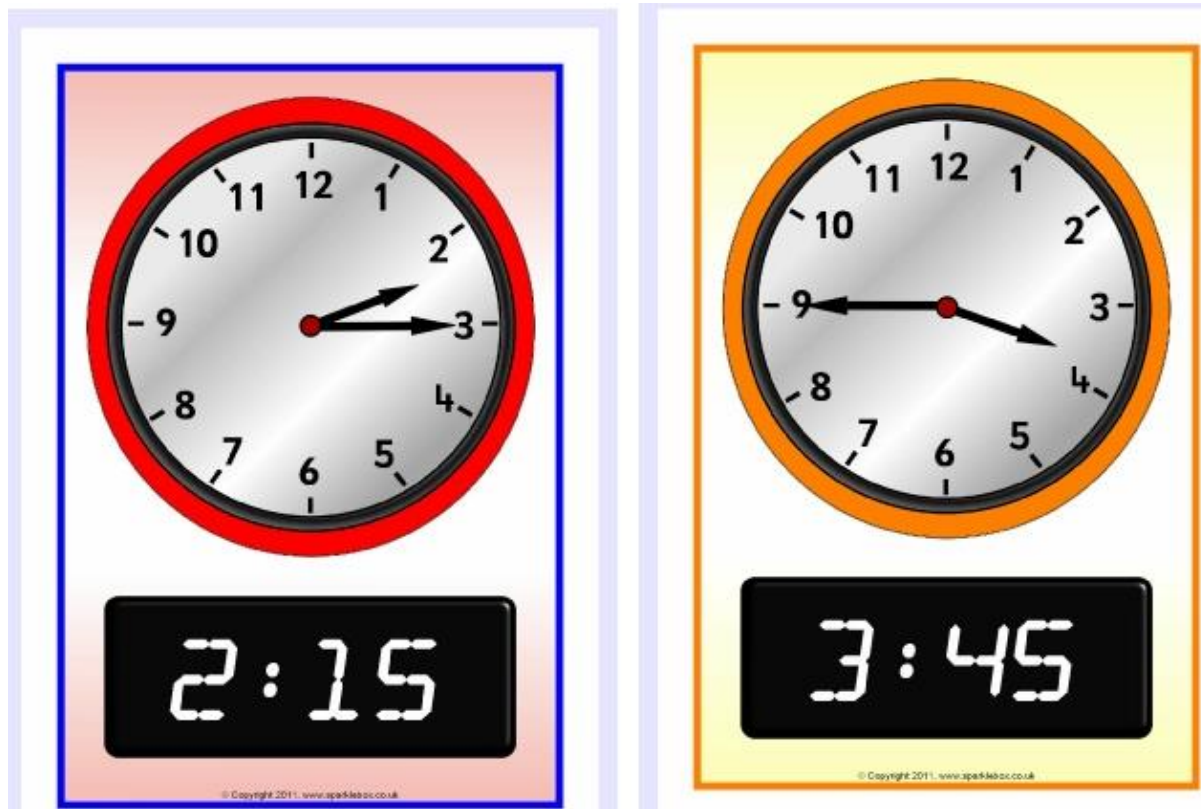

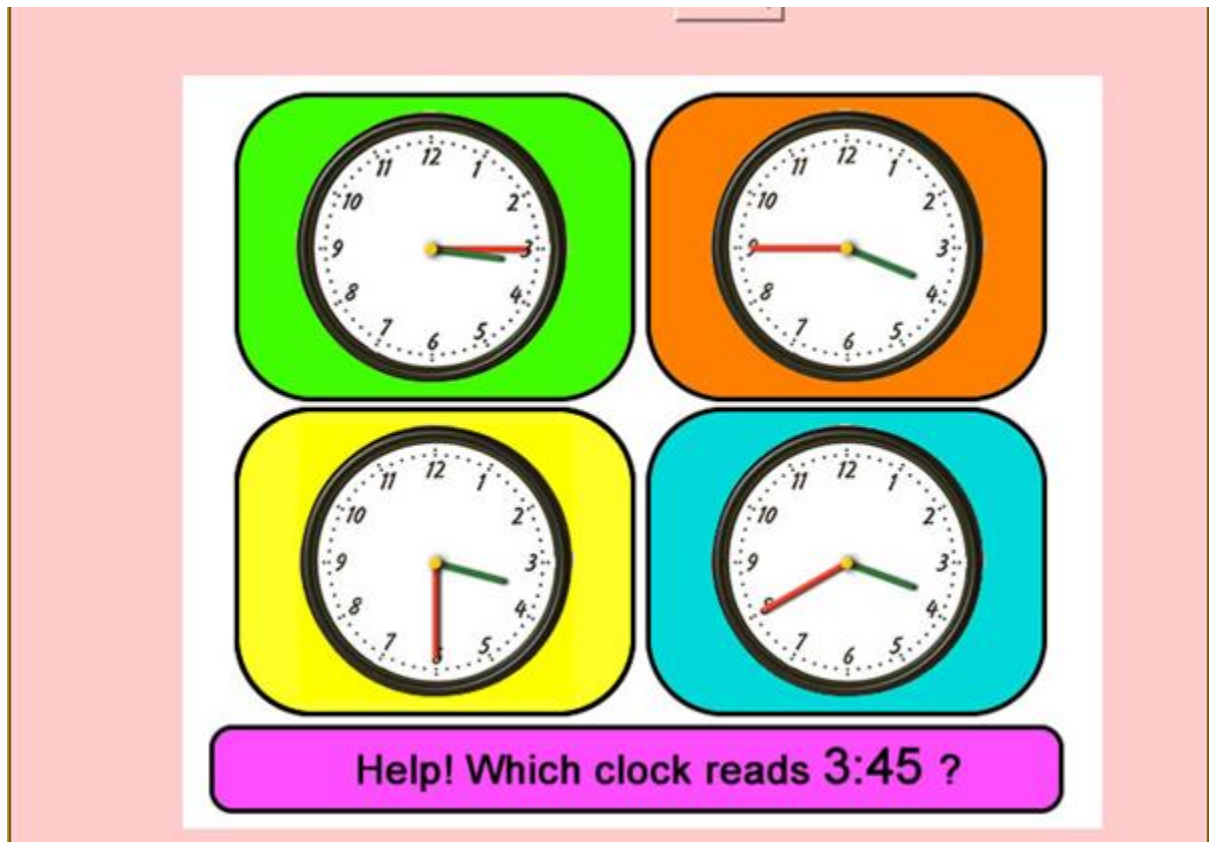

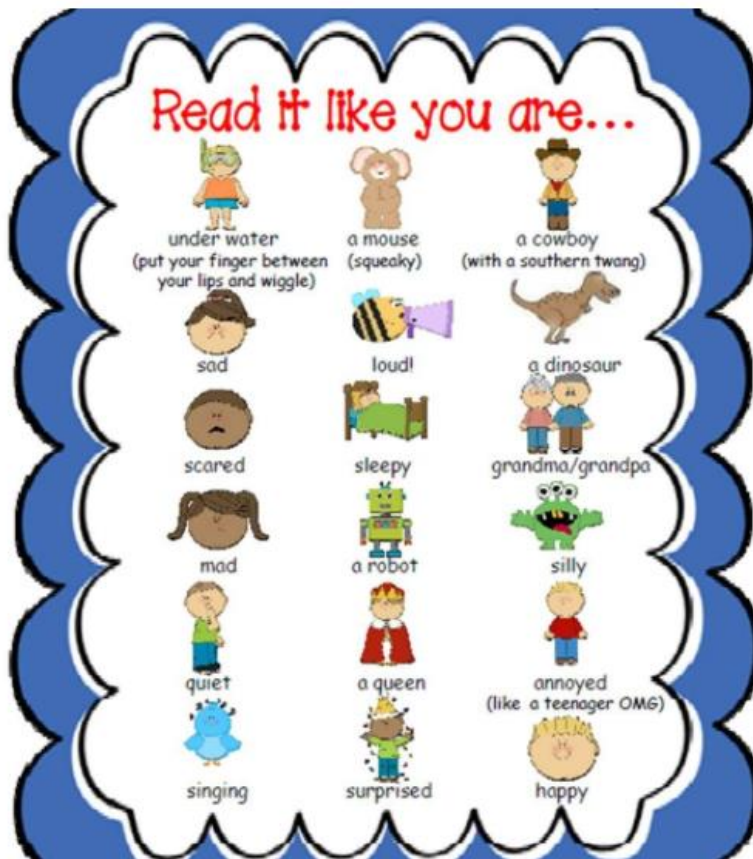

# Nouns

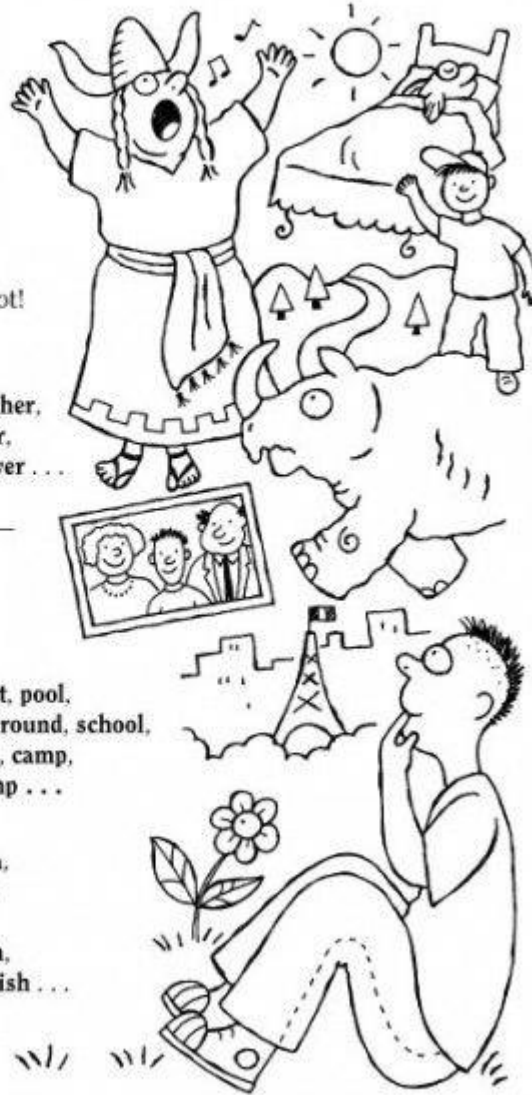
A noun is
